## HOW WE PLANT A TOMATO

IN THE BOTTOM of a $20^{\prime \prime}$ deep $\times 12^{\prime \prime}$ diameter hole, put:

1/3 cup FISH MEAL
1/2 cup FISH BONE MEAL
1/3 cup MYKOS

1/2 cup WORM CASTINGS
1/4 cup OYSTER SHELL
1/3 cup ORGANIC 4-6-3 FERTILIZER


1/3 teaspoon MICRONIZED AZOMITE

Before planting the tomato plant, prepare as follows:

- Trim off the lower branches exposing $3^{\prime \prime}-5^{\prime \prime}$ of the main stem. You want to plant not only the root ball but $3^{\prime \prime}-5^{\prime \prime}$ of the stem. It sounds weird but your plants will thrive!
- Dust the root ball with $1 / 4$ cup Mykos.
- Place the plant in a hole and use a high quality potting mix combined with soil to backfill.

All done! Now take good care of your plants and enjoy your delicious tomatoes!
