

# HOW WE PLANT A TOMATO

IN THE BOTTOM of a 20" deep x 12" diameter hole, put:

1/3 cup **FISH MEAL**

1/2 cup **FISH BONE MEAL**

1/3 cup **MYKOS**

1/2 cup **WORM CASTINGS**

1/4 cup **OYSTER SHELL**

1/3 cup **ORGANIC 4-6-3 FERTILIZER**

1/3 teaspoon **MICRONIZED AZOMITE**

**TERRA**  
**AMICO** **FARMS**

**Before planting the tomato plant, prepare as follows:**

- Trim off the lower branches exposing 3" - 5" of the main stem. You want to plant not only the root ball but 3" - 5" of the stem. It sounds weird but your plants will thrive!
- Dust the root ball with ¼ cup Mykos.
- Place the plant in a hole and use a high quality potting mix combined with soil to backfill.

All done! Now take good care of your plants and enjoy your delicious tomatoes!
