HOW WE PLANT A TOMATO

IN THE BOTTOM of a 20" deep x 12" diameter hole, put:

1/3 cup FISH MEAL

1/2 cup FISH BONE MEAL

1/3 cup **MYKOS**

1/2 cup **WORM CASTINGS**

1/4 cup **OYSTER SHELL**

1/3 cup ORGANIC 4-6-3 FERTILIZER

1/3 teaspoon MICRONIZED AZOMITE



Before planting the tomato plant, prepare as follows:

- Trim off the lower branches exposing 3" 5" of the main stem. You want to plant not only the root ball but 3" 5" of the stem. It sounds weird but your plants will thrive!
- Dust the root ball with ¼ cup Mykos.
- Place the plant in a hole and use a high quality potting mix combined with soil to backfill.

All done! Now take good care of your plants and enjoy your delicious tomatoes!
